ALL ITEMS MUST BE HANDCRAFTED. NO COMMERCIAL ITEMS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Vendors with commercial items will be asked to leave and will not be invited back. The booth holder shall exhibit items for sale during business hours. Booths are not to be taken down until 4:00 PM on Sunday. Vendor will be responsible to bring your own tables, backdrops and change funds. Chairs will be provided. No nails may be used on any surfaces. Vendors are responsible for payment of any/all sales taxes.

Please remove all trash and displays from the building.

No smoking on campus.

Parking is limited and we would like to reserve as much parking on campus for customers as possible. We have space for you to park at the back of our building. As soon as you unload please park.

Each booth that needs electricity is limited to 500 watts. These are the strict guidelines from the Fire Marshal and failure to follow the diagram can result in loss of electricity upon the Fire Marshal's inspection on Saturday morning.

Vendors must not touch or handle another vendor's property unless asked to do so by that vendor. Failure to follow this may result in your immediate dismissal and removal from the craft fair and could result in a rescinded invitation for the following year.

Make sure you have someone in charge of your booth at all times. We have artist relief by staff if needed.

We have WIFI available to you.
